PAINTING GUIDELINES:

- Be creative with the theme
- Acrylic or exterior paint recommended
- Paint the board edges to prevent weather damage

SEALING GUIDELINES:

- Sealing your own board after painting is a BIG help to staff
- We recommend 2+ coats of sealer on both sides and all 4 edges

PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES:

As a participant in the Prairie Art Exhibit, you understand & agree:

- The exhibit will be displayed to the public on the prairie at the Wallace Farm from May 31 to October 1
- Your exhibit becomes WCI property UNLESS you arrange for pick up after the exhibit ends and **no later than December 1** (we'll contact you when ready, probably mid-October)
- Your exhibit may be photographed and/or used for WCI marketing purposes without remuneration
- Exhibits that become WCI property can be repurposed without remuneration
- The Wallace Centers of Iowa is not responsible for damage, loss or theft
