PRIVATE EVENT DINING OPTIONS

As often as possible, the Wallace Centers of Iowa culinary team incorporates organically-grown fruits, vegetables and herbs harvested at the Wallace Farm. We also use locally-sourced ingredients from other Iowa farmers such as meat, eggs, grains, produce and cheese.

MENU OPTIONS

Meals include a garden salad, homemade seasonal dessert, water, iced tea and coffee. Beer and wine are available for purchase. Meals are priced per person with a minimum of 20 and maximum of 65. Price is all-inclusive of food and service.

Select one menu option for all. Special dietary needs can be accommodated with advance notice.

CHICKEN SALAD SANDWICH | \$18

grapes, celery, pecans on artisan bread

PULLED PORK SANDWICH | \$19

apple butter BBQ sauce, house pickles on an artisan bun

HOUSEMADE PASTA | \$19 or \$22 with chicken

choice of vegetable ragu or garden greens pesto, seasonal vegetables

IOWA HAM BALLS | \$23

brown sugar glaze, seasonal vegetables, garlic mashed potatoes

PORK CHOP | \$25

apple butter glaze, herb roasted potatoes, seasonal vegetables

HERBED CHICKEN BREAST | \$24

seasonal vegetables, garlic roasted potatoes, chicken jus

Confirmation of menu selection and total # of attendees are required at least 7 days prior to the event. You will be charged for this confirmed number. All prices and options are valid if booked before Dec. 31, 2026.

FEATURES OF THE BIRTHPLACE FARM

Henry A. Wallace was elected US Vice President, yet his place in "America's first family of agriculture" was by virtue of his birth. Early in his career, he founded a world-renowned seed corn company and was an editor of Wallaces' Farmer magazine. He served as Vice President during WWII in addition to holding cabinet positions before and after the war.

Open year-round, the Wallace Farm is a 40-acre parcel of the family's original 160-acre farm, now on the National Register of Historic Places. This site includes:
